

PLAN YEAR COVERAGE PERIODS FOR 2024-25

The term “*Academic Year*” is hereby deleted and replaced with the term “*Plan Year*” (refer to Definitions in this Amendment). The effective date is September 1, 2024, and the end date is August 31, 2025

MODIFICATIONS FOR 2023-24 PLAN YEAR

The following are modifications for the 2023-24 *Plan Year* for the SAHF, for services or benefits provided under Section V, Coordination of Benefits

- Carbon Health shall refund any benefit payments made by MassHealth (Medicaid), TRICARE, or other governmental payers of last resort that were received during the 2023-24 Plan Year.

MODIFICATIONS FOR 2024-25 PLAN YEAR

Effective for the 2024-25 *Plan Year*, under Section V, Coordination of Benefits, the SAHF will provide 100 percent (100%) coverage for any SAHF Covered Services and Supplies specified in Section VI for students covered by Medicaid, Medicare, TRICARE, or other governmental insurance that has a payer of last resort provision. Because there will be no patient responsibility after SAHF benefits are provided as a primary payer, Carbon Health will not submit billing to these governmental payers.

For students covered by commercial insurance plans or who are self-pay, the SAHF will provide 100 percent (100%) coverage for any charges for pap smears and *Routine Physicals* for charges not covered by students’ commercial health insurance. Charges for pap smears are only covered for services provided by Carbon Student Health at the Tree House clinic location. Reference lab charges are not covered.

Effective for the 2024-25 Plan Year, this provision is stricken from Section I, Establishment of SAHF.

The Plan Sponsor provides SAHF for the sole purpose of providing health care benefits and services to SAHF Covered Students.~~

Effective for the 2024-25 Plan Year, this provision is stricken from Section VII, Exclusions.

DEFINITIONS, Section XI

The following definition is hereby removed:

~~*Academic Year.* The period beginning September 1, 2023, through August 31, 2024. The SAHF benefits and this Plan Document automatically renew for subsequent Academic Years unless SAHF benefits are terminated or amended by the Plan Sponsor.~~

The following definitions are hereby added.

Plan Year. Unless otherwise specified, Plan Year means a 12-month period beginning September 1 and ending August 31. SAHF benefits and this Plan Document automatically renew for subsequent Plan Years unless SAHF benefits are terminated or amended by the Plan Sponsor

Routine Physicals means a visit intended to assess overall health and perform preventive measures and screenings. Routine Physicals does not include pre-employment, pre-athletic (except as specifically provided for sports physicals), or other program/agency pre-admission/participation purposes.

MODIFICATIONS FOR APPENDIX 1 LIST OF CPT CODES
